A special thanks to Jack Martin for taking notes and providing the Meeting Minutes input from the January meeting.

Chris Green and Paul Stoops co-chaired the meeting and explained some of the changes that have taken place in the administration of the Northwest Woodworkers Association by a Steering Committee in the absence of a President.

The President and Program Chairman positions are still open and the Steering Committee would like to fill them as soon as possible. If you are interested in filling either of these positions, please contact one of the Steering Committee members.

A discussion of programs and results of the membership survey produced a lively interchange of ideas among the membership. Members were encouraged to share their ideas and knowledge by giving short, informal presentations of woodworking topics or projects with which they were the most comfortable. Suggestions included your shop, the kind of equipment you own and why you chose it. Other suggested topics included visiting a manufacturing facility to see how equipment is made, bending wood, dust collection equipment/installation, how to make hand cut dovetails, visit to a sawmill, and visit to a harp maker. The Association still needs someone to volunteer to fill the Program Chairman position.

A suggestion was made that we consider adding some sort of forum feature to our website in which members could get their questions answered and assistance on their woodworking projects and related issues.

A new "What's New?" feature was added to this meeting to give members an opportunity to share about new tools, techniques, articles, websites, and other woodworking information. Herb Stoops started the ball rolling by showing us a new Skil router package with fixed and plunge bases. He also showed a nifty new battery powered drill-driver which was equipped with a rotating magazine like a six shooter to hold a variety of bits – he didn't show us the holster or demonstrate his quick draw, however! Maybe next meeting.....:-)

It was announced that we will have a 2×4 Challenge contest in the near future. Ground rules for the Challenge are being developed by the Steering Committee. Time to start thinking about unique project(s) you could make from an ordinary 2×4 .
